The event was a success as members that haven't fished many tournaments were able to fish with some of the club's most experienced anglers. The tournament was won by the team of Debbie and Harold Alewine with 4 striped bass weighing 25 lbs. Debbie will be heading into December in first place in the race for MSC Angler of the Year.

Finishing second with 24.15 lbs. was the team of Lee Thomas, Michael Spires and ride along guest Tony Clark. In third place was the team of Dean Preston and David Sellers with 24.4 lbs.

The MSC AC/Delco Voyager Lunger, weighing 8.14 lbs., was landed by Lee Thomas. The Big Fish also won the Nichol's Store big fish prize. The winner of November's lowest legal creel weight was Townsend Wessinger with 4.4 lbs.

Tournament Statistics:
