 Finishing second was David Sturgis from McConnells with 26.6 lbs. Kreg  
 Frady finished third with two fish weighing 24.10 lbs. Kreg also landed  
 the MSC AC/Delco Voyager Lunker, weighing a whopping 20.7 lbs. The  
 big fish also won the Nichols Store of Rock Hill Big Fish prize.

The winner of January's lowest legal creel weight was MSC's 2006  
 Youth Angler of the Year Weston Thomas from Lexington with 3.8lbs.
