### Matt "Ice Fly" Southard Wins In October!

On a day of tough fishing for most, Midland Striper Club's angler tournament held October 15 was won by Matt Southard from York with a limit of three striped bass weighing 19.7 lbs.

Finishing in second place with 17.11 lbs. was James "Fogman" Lindler from West Columbia. In third place was Debbie Alewine from Rock Hill with 15.15 lbs.

The MSCAC/Delco Voyager Lunker, weighing 7.15 lbs., was landed by Michael Spires. The big fish also won the monthly MSC Nichol's Store big fish prize. Nichol's Store is in Rock Hill S.C. October's lowest legal creel weight winner was David Sellars with 3.4 lbs.

#### Tournament Statistics:

**54 people paid to fish. 15 anglers weighed 27 fish at an average of 5.10 lbs.**

#### November 2004 Tournament...

With unseasonably mild temperatures to begin the day, the fish also heated up the boat of Tony Carroll, Wynn Corley and Marshall West even further, allowing them to place first with four striper weighing 30-12 including the 9-6 AC/Delco Voyager Lunker for November.

In second place was the boat of Jim Fiber, Mike Johnson and Arthur Simmons with a limit weighing 28-2. The team of Michael Spires, Lee Thomas and Taylor Thomas finished a very close 3rd with their limit weighing 20-0. 49 paid to fish and 14 boats weighed in 41 striper at an average of 5.84 pounds.
